Parking

You can park directly outside the clinic entrance, (see below), if these spaces are full, we have more parking in the visitor's car park, (which is the yard immediately as you drive in through the gate). If you require a space directly outside the door for accessibility or safety reasons, please let us know and we can reserve you a space.

Upon Arrival

If a session is taking place when you arrive, please wait in your car until the patient leaves. We will know you are waiting.

Wheelchair Access

There is a small threshold at the front entrance. If you need level access, we can show you where to come in at the rear of the building.

Driving Directions

From the A127 –

- Turn off the A127 at the junction for Brentwood (Half Way House A128).
- Follow the signs to Brentwood driving through Herongate and then Ingrave.
- As you leave Ingrave you will go through a white gate on either side and enter a 50mph zone. On the right is a large cream house – slow down and indicate right, you are almost there.
- Drive past the white gates next to the house and the two big trees, and turn into the next driveway.

From Brentwood –

- From Wilsons Corner at the top of the High Street, drive down the A128 Ingrave Road towards the A127.
- Drive over Shenfield Common crossroads and continue down the road, straight over a mini roundabout and King Georges Playing Fields on your right.
- Continue for about a mile and go straight over the next 2 roundabouts and into a 50mph zone.
- Go round a sharp left-hand bend and then signal left and slow down.
- You will see tall trees and cream house ahead on your left - turn into the first drive on your left, just **before** the red brick buildings. If you get to the cream house, you have gone too far.
